### **LECTIONARY READINGS:**

Today's first reading is from **Philippians 4:4-9**.

Be full of joy in the Lord always. I will say again, be full of joy. Let everyone see that you are gentle and kind. The Lord is coming soon. Do not worry about anything. But pray and ask God for everything you need. And when you pray, always give thanks. And God's peace will keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. The peace that God gives is so great that we cannot understand it.

Brothers and sisters, continue to think about the things that are good and worthy of praise. Think about the things that are true and honourable and right and pure and beautiful and respected. And do what you learned and received from me. Do what I told you and what you saw me do. And the God who gives peace will be with you.

### **GOSPEL READING**

Reader: Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John.  
**All: Glory to you, O Lord.**

The people found Jesus on the other side of the lake. They asked him, "Teacher, when did you come here?"

Jesus answered, "Are you looking for me because you saw me do miracles? No! I tell you the truth. You are looking for me because you ate the bread and were

satisfied. Earthly food spoils and ruins. So don't work to get that kind of food. But work to get the food that stays good always and gives you eternal life. The Son of Man will give you that food. God the Father has shown that he is with the Son of Man."

The people asked Jesus, "What are the things God wants us to do?"

Jesus answered, "The work God wants you to do is this: to believe in the One that God sent."

So the people asked, "What miracle will you do? If we can see a miracle, then we will believe you. What will you do? Our ancestors ate the manna in the desert. This is written in the Scriptures: 'God gave them bread from heaven to eat.'"

Jesus said, "I tell you the truth. Moses was not the one who gave you bread from heaven. But my Father gives you the true bread from heaven. God's bread is the One who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."
